CAN I SET UP BEFORE MY EVENT?

If there are no other bookings in before yours (bookings could be added at any time), you may be able to set up before your session. However, if you wish to guarantee an early set up especially for parties, we recommend booking the session before yours to avoid disappointment.

CAN I USE THE KITCHEN?

Yes, we have 2 kitchens one fully equipped for food preparation, with oven, hob, fridge, freezer, dishwashers, cutlery, crockery, table cloths and tea towels. This kitchen should be booked if you would like exclusive use. We also have a small kitchen in the committee room bar area. Please remember to bring your own tea, coffee, sugar and milk.

ARE WE ABLE TO HAVE A CATERING VAN?

Yes, however the catering van would need to be self sufficient e.g. bring their own generator for power.

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DO YOU HAVE TABLES AND CHAIRS AVAILABLE FOR USE?

Yes, there are plenty of tables and chairs available. These will need to be set up and tidied away during your session time unless you have booked a further session.

DO YOU HAVE A PROJECTOR OR SCREEN?

No, we don't have a projector available but there is a big screen in the committee room. Projections can also be made onto the wall in the main hall.

IS THERE A MUSIC SYSTEM?

Yes, you can use the auxiliary cable to plug into your phone / tablet or laptop and you will be able to control the volume through your device. If you have an Apple device you will need an auxiliary to lightning Jack to connect your phone

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IS THERE A STAGE AVAILABLE?

Yes, we do have a stage. Please book in advance and we will install it for you. There is a small fee to cover the time taken to install and dismantle the stage.

AM I RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING?

Yes, you will need to leave the hall as you found it, including the toilets.

AM I RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE?

Yes, you will be responsible for any damage caused to the fabric of the hall.
