

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How high is the hall?

3meters high at the lowest light fitting. But the hall is split by 3 Oak frame which 3.4m wide in between each frame.

Can I have a bouncy castle?

Yes you may, but this is at your own risk and we (the village hall committee and building) take no responsibility or liability.

How many chairs and tables do you have?

There are approximately 90 chairs and enough tables to sit people around them. There are approximately 10 large 6ft tables and 10 3ft tables. These are securely stored inside the hall. The chairs are mainly fabric and there are 20 plastic chairs which can also be used outside.

Do you have plates, bowls and cutlery?

Yes, when you hire the hall, you have access to cups and saucers, mugs, glassware, side plates, main plates and dessert bowls. There is enough for approximately 80-90 people. If you require more, you may need to consider bringing items in.

Is there a cooker?

Yes, there is a double range oven which you can use, it has an electric cooker and gas hob top, there is also a microwave too.

Is there a fridge?

Yes, there is a small under counter fridge in the kitchen and further fridge available in one of the side rooms, please note there is no freezer.

Is the hall heated?

Yes, the hall is set up with a heating system that comes on and off as required the main heating is through the floor system in the main hall.

Is there access for a wheelchair?

Yes, we have a double entrance door and a ramp is available for people to use to aid wheelchairs from the road and onto the pavement, we also have a disabled toilet.

Is there parking?

Yes, there is a small off road car park opposite the hall, which would hold around 20 cars max (but you will have to block people in. If you park on the road please DO NOT obstruct the pavement.

Is there WIFI?

Yes, please use sensible.

Is there a sound system?

Yes, you will have access to wireless speakers so you can play your own music through a device.

How do we clean the hall after our hire?

We provide all cleaning products and mops etc in our cleaning cupboard and these are free for you to use.

How do we dispose of rubbish?

We have BLUE bin lid is for recycling, paper, can, glass, cardboard. Everything else goes into the large GREEN lid waste (you need a key).
