

Alcohol Licence

The Berden Sports & Social Club has an Alcohol Licence which authorises it to serve alcoholic drinks to club members and guests – who must sign in. If you are paying the Sports & Social Club to run the Bar for you, then you and your guests will be asked to sign in and you will be covered by the above licence.

If you are planning to sell alcoholic drinks at any public or private event, then you (the Hirer) are responsible for applying for a Temporary Event Notice (TEN).

You'll need to contact Uttlesford District Council for a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) if you want to carry out a 'licensable activity' on unlicensed premises.

Committee Officers are entitled to request confirmation that such a licence has been obtained (by display of licence) before permitting the sale of liquor to proceed. It shall be the responsibility of the Hirer to ensure that all the Laws and Regulations associated with such licences are strictly complied with.
