

Q & A for Biddestone Village Hall

How big is the hall?

The dimensions can be found under the Documentation tab on the main page.

Does the hall have heating?

Yes, the hall is heated and will be warm when you arrive.

Does the hall have Wi-Fi?

Yes, the password can be found under the Documentation tab on the main page.

How do I pay for the hall?

The preferred method of payment is via the online payment system, however if this is not possible, then you can pay by cheque. You will receive two invoices, one for the main booking and one for the deposit, the deposit is refunded after the event subject to observing the conditions of the hire.

Can I use outdoor spaces?

The children's play area is available but is not exclusive to your hire. You will have the use of the patio outside of the room you have booked.

Are Bouncy Castles allowed on site?

Bouncy castles are permitted inside and outside the village hall. The maximum dimension inside the Main Hall is 10ftWx10fLtx10ftH, but the booker must advise the Administrator prior to the event.

How many tables are there in the Village Hall?

**6 off wooden tables - 150 x 75cm and 14 off folding tables - 120 x 69cm (Main Hall)
14 off folding tables (Club Room). Plenty of chairs are also available in both rooms.**

Are Fireworks permitted at the Village Hall?

No fireworks are permitted due to the livestock in the area

Is there a freezer in the kitchen?

No freezer but there is a fridge, microwave and oven and plenty of crockery and cutlery.

Please bring your own tea towels, bin bags etc

Are horses allowed on the premises grounds?

No livestock, i.e. horses, sheep etc. are allowed on the premises or surrounding outside area.

Are we allowed to bring our own alcohol?

No alcohol is allowed on the premises and must be bought from our own bar which you can add to your booking.

How do we access the premises?

A Village Hall Committee member will meet you on the day to open up and allow you access.

Is roller skating allowed in the village hall?

No roller skating is permitted inside the village hall.
