All persons who use our premises shall be aware of any concerns, such as abuse, harm, danger or bullying toward children.

This can manifest within gatherings without noticing, it is the duty of everyone to address any issue they feel constitutes harm in any shape or form.

Report to the person responsible observations and ultimately to the County Council.

Adult supervisors must ensure children do not wander off the premises and do not enter the kitchen without supervision.

Whilst we are insured for Public Liability, persons contracting equipment hire such as discos, bouncy castles etc have a safety certificate or PAT tested to operate in the public domain.
