

Brightwalton Village Hall FAQs

Here are some of the questions we're often asked.

Can we have a bouncy castle in the West (new) hall?

Yes. See the plan below for height restrictions. The red line in the West hall shows the position of a single tie bar which goes across the hall, limiting the height there to about 2.4m. Either side of the tie bar there is a height of about 3.5m or more in the middle so if the bouncy castle can fit either side, then the height will be sufficient. Please ask if you'd like to view before booking your bouncy castle. We accept no liability and please ensure that the inflatable does not damage the floor.



Can we use the field?

Yes, and this is a great feature of the hall. The field is available to the public so you will not have exclusive access to it or be able to formally close off a private area. However, people are generally respectful of private parties near the hall.

If you have children at your event, please also note that there's a play park to the other side of the hall.

How do we access the wifi?

Our wifi and internet is supplied in partnership with Gigaclear. Please contact the Bookings Coordinator for access details for your event. You may not use these services for any unlawful manner or to knowingly send, receive, upload, download, or use any material which:

How will my deposit be refunded?

The Bookings Coordinator will refund your deposit by bank transfer as soon as possible after satisfactory inspection, and within 28 days. He will ask you to provide bank details by email.

What facilities are available in the kitchens?

In the West (new) hall kitchen there are approximately 35 large plates, 70 small plates, 16 cups and saucers, 100 small mugs, 12 large mugs, 20 breakfast bowls, 30 assorted glasses, a large jug, a tea urn and a large teapot.

In the East (old) hall kitchen there are approximately 20 large plates, 30 mugs, 14 glasses.

Note crockery is not matching.

Each kitchen has an oven with grill, hob and under counter fridge (2 in the West (new) hall). The East (old) hall has a microwave. There are no dishwashers but washing up liquid and dishcloths are supplied. Please bring additional tea towels. Hot water is provided automatically in the West kitchen. In the East kitchen there is a switch above the work surface to turn on the hot water heater. You will also

find a roll of bin bags in which to collect your rubbish. Please take all rubbish and recycling home as the hall does not have a regular collection service.
