

Burton Leonard Village Hall



Burton Leonard Village Hall was built in 1930 but has been frequently updated and is maintained in excellent condition throughout. It has served the village very well as a hub for community activity of all descriptions and is available for hire to most outside groups and individuals. It consists of a large hall, a modern kitchen and associated facilities.

The hall is approximately 11.5 meters long and about 7 meters wide and can accommodate 100 people readily in rows of seating or 120 if standing. The hall has a wooden floor and works well for dancing. The hall also has a stage (5 by 9 meters) which has proper curtains, simple stage lighting and changing facilities.



The kitchen is 4.7 meters square and was completely modernised in April 2021. It has a fridge, hob and two ovens with grills. It also has a plate warmer, a commercial dishwasher, a refrigerated cabinet for drinks and a shuttered counter giving direct access to the hall. The kitchen is large enough to accommodate small meetings and can be hired separately for that purpose.

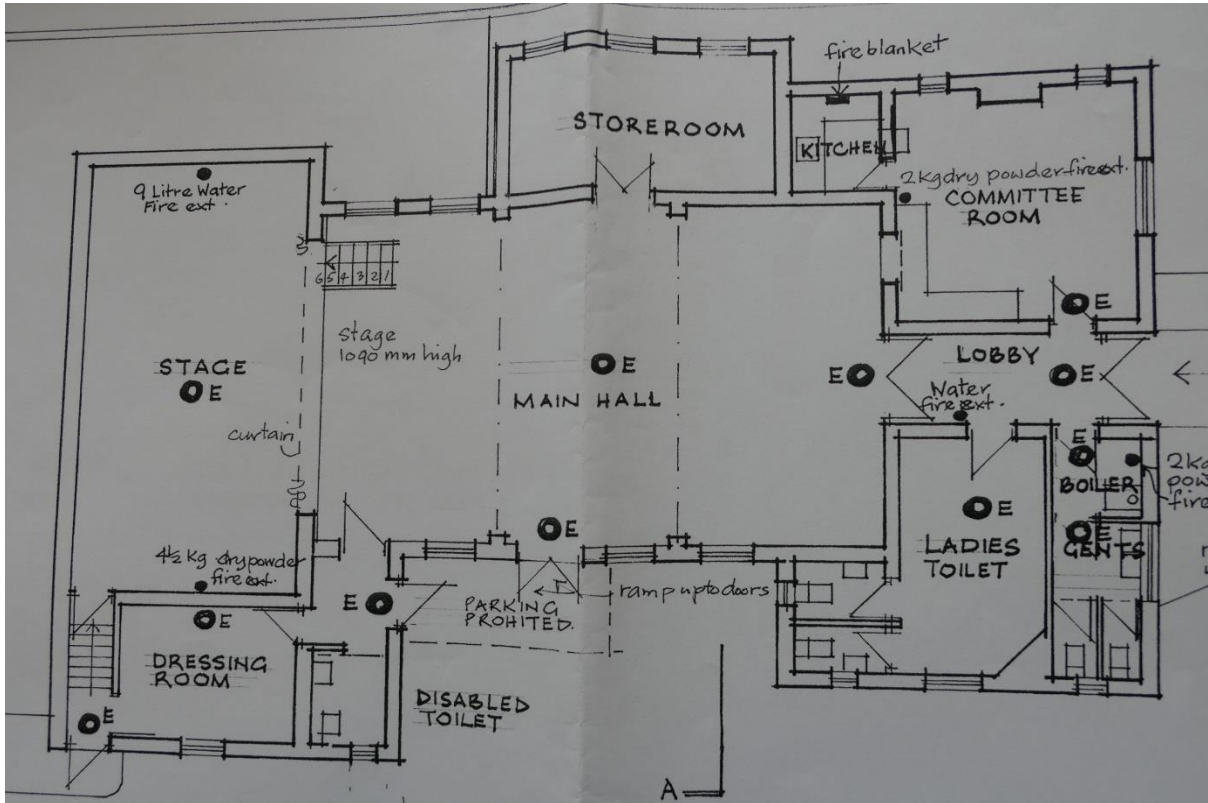


The hall has Wi-Fi and all mains' services including gas which powers the heating system through a modern boiler installed in September 2016.

The village hall has all the facilities necessary to help make a success of your event or celebration. You will have the use of ample chairs and tables of various sizes included in your hire and the kitchen has cutlery and table linen available. The hall also has an air purifier and a simple PA system. There are separate toilets for men and women and people with disabilities. The hall is fully compliant with all health and safety requirements and is fitted with a hearing loop.
