



PARKING GUIDANCE

Westgate Leisure Centre (400 yards distance)

Parking is available in Westgate Leisure Centre car park for free for 2 hours and is a short walk past Chichester College on the left to Mount Lane where you will find Chichester City Arts Centre on your right.

If you park at the back of the Westgate leisure Centre and walk towards the College with the skate park on your right, it takes 3 minutes. Please remember to print a parking ticket by pressing the button and display in your car.

Parklands Road

There are limited spaces (approx. 10) for 1 hour no return parking in Parklands Road to the north of Westgate. It is then a very short walk across the road to the Centre.

Westgate (the street next to the Centre)

In Westgate itself, there are No Restrictions after 5.00pm but spaces are limited.

Local Car Parks

There are city car parks close-by to the Centre. The nearest is Orchard Street Car Park. Avenue de Chartres multi-story Car Park is adjacent to the roundabout between Avenue de Chartres and Via Ravenna.

Cycling and Public Transport

Cyclists may store their bicycles in the cycle rack to the left of the Reception door or on request in our enclosed back garden via the lockable gate. Please note cyclists store their bicycles at their own risk.

The train and bus station are a short walk to the Centre.

No Parking in Mount Lane.

There is no parking in Mount Lane. There are double yellow lines on all sides before it becomes a public footpath used by many pedestrians and cyclists. Please note the only vehicles allowed beyond the double yellow lines are the residents and visitors to numbers 1 to 4 Mount Lane. Do not drive down Mount Lane to drop off in the Lane or to turn around. Any visitors to the Centre who are authorized to park on-site should reverse into the site and take great care to avoid pedestrians and cyclists.
