

Great Barford Village Hall

General Information

The Great Barford **Village Hall** was built in 1995 replacing the old village hall which stood in Silver Street. It is situated at the end of Fishers Close, next to the village Playing Field, with parking for 56 cars.

The **Main Hall** (9m x 16m) with the **Stage** area (4m x 5m) is an excellent large area suitable for a variety of events. Maximum capacity is 180 people.

The **Bar Room** (5m x 8m) is adjacent to the main hall but separated by folding doors which can be opened to create one large space, excellent for parties and events. The bar itself serves both rooms.

The large **Kitchen** was refurbished in 2020 and contains double oven, hob, warming cupboard, 2 fridges and a microwave, crockery and cutlery for more than 100 with a serving hatch opening into the hall.

There is a marked **Badminton Court** on the wooden floor, LED lights in the 6.7m high ceiling and coloured lights around the ceiling and a central disco ball which is a great feature for parties.

The Toilet block includes Gents and Ladies (refurbished in 2016), Disabled/Baby Changing facility, as well as Changing Rooms, which can be accessed separately from outside.

In the store room, there are rectangular folding **Tables** (5' and 10' long) and 150 newly reupholstered **Chairs**. There are more round tables and lounge chairs in the Bar Room.

We hold a PRS Licence and Premises Licence for alcohol sales and music. Power for music reproduction is provided through a noise limiter, which is set to an environmentally acceptable level.
