# **Hambledon Village Hall Surrey**

## **Covid Information - August 2022**

Please do not come to the hall if you have tested positive for Covid or if you have any of the symptoms of Covid.

## Please use the hand-sanitiser provided on entering the hall.

Whilst there are now no government rules in place, measures can be taken to reduce the risk of spreading Covid and we would encourage you to consider employing them, especially if your event is likely to be crowded and/or there will be vulnerable people attending.

#### These measures include:

- Using the hand sanitiser available on entering the hall and after coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose.
- Opening windows to provide ventilation. Please ensure that all windows are closed on leaving the hall.
- Wearing face coverings.
- Limiting the amount of people in small spaces at any one time. For example allowing only two people at a time in the kitchen or toilets.
- You might want to consider washing crockery and cutlery before use. Please use the
  dish cloths and tea towels provided and leave them on the draining board at the end
  of the hire so that they can be washed.
- Wiping frequently-used surfaces with antibacterial spray.
- Social distancing.
- Reducing the risk of droplet transmission by avoiding situations where people need to shout or raise their voices to be heard eg refrain from playing music at a volume which makes normal conversation difficult.
- Where a sports, exercise or performing arts activity takes place, organise the activity in accordance with any guidelines issued by the relevant governing body.
- If someone becomes unwell with suspected Covid-19 symptoms, arrange for them to go home or move them to the designated safe area which is in the lobby by Fire Exit 1. Provide tissues and a bin or plastic bag, and a bowl of warm soapy water for handwashing. Please inform the hall caretaker, Martyn Grove, on 07768 294 845.

### **Potential Hall Closures**

- We will have the right to close the hall if there are safety concerns relating to COVID-19, for example, if someone attending the hall develops symptoms and deepcleaning is required or in the event that public buildings are required or advised to close again.
