Main Hall

Regulars hourly rate £16

Non-regulars hourly rate £20

Regulars who use the main hall will be allowed inclusive use of the kitchen for refreshments, subject to the small hall not being used for any other event.

Changing rooms and private toilets can be included at no additional charge.

Small hall which includes the kitchen and committee room:-

Regulars hourly rate £16

Non-regulars hourly rate £20

Subject to availability, the changing rooms and private toilets can be included at no additional charge.


Set up and clear up/cleaning time must be included in all bookings.

A regular user is defined as a group or persons who use either hall more than 26 times per calendar year.

A minimum deposit for use of either hall by non-regulars is £40 per hall. Bookings cannot be honoured without a deposit.

The £16 rate may be offered to non-regulars who are a local charity or a good cause, judged on a case-by-case basis, at the discretion of the manager and a director.

Bouncy Castles or other power inflatables may be used within the main hall. This is providing that only the 13amp electrical sockets



Full use of the Centre (both halls and supporting facilities).

Regulars £400 per day.

Non-regulars £500 per day.

For weddings and funerals set up time and take down/cleaning time the day before and after will be allowed inclusive in this rate providing no other events clash.

Other information.

All areas hired must be returned clean and tidy with waste and recycling carried out. Otherwise, a charge of £20 per hour will be applied.

All hall users must be aware that the toilets accessed from the lobby area are also for public use and therefore not exclusive use during events. Public access hours in high season are normally 08:00-20:00 and low season 08:30-17:00. We may vary these summer hours particularly at weekends if the situation justifies early closure. During a wedding or funeral the lobby may be closed off to the public for privacy.

The community fridge/food team will have access to their area every evening typically between 19:00-21:00.
