Notes

1. **Private & Commercial Use must include setting up and clearing away time in the hours booked (usually 30 minutes set-up and 30 minutes for clearing away). Cleaning equipment can be found under kitchen sink, and the hoover is located in cupboard under stage.**
2. **The Hall should be left as found. Hall users must clear all personal items, decorations, food, drink and waste material out of the hall. A Cleaning Fee of £30.00 can be included in your hire if you want the Hall Cleaning Team to clean the hall after your booking however any rubbish must still be cleared by the user. Cleaning services must be requested at time of booking.**
3. **A set daily charge of £10 per day will be made to any group or individual that leaves the heating and or lighting on.**

- 4. Private users must pay a deposit of £100 for functions where alcohol will be served or brought in . This will only be refunded if hall is left as found.**
- 5. New non-profit groups hosting an activity which is open to the community and less than four hours in duration will be free for the first four consecutive bookings (available once per organisation). For non-profit bookings which are more than four hours long per booking, a reduced rate will be applied at the discretion of the Hall**
- 6. Commercial rates will apply if there is no community benefit or charitable purpose connected to the booking.**
