

ST JAMES CHURCH HALL, NAYLAND

HIRE CHARGES as of March 2026

The Church Hall is at 66 Bear Street and is available for hire to anybody.

It consists of a 26' x 18' main hall, an accessible WC and a small kitchen area, including a sink, microwave and kettle.

The Hall is equipped with 48 chairs, 8 lightweight tables (each seating 6 people) as well as 8 card tables.

The kitchen area has crockery for 40, 60 cups and saucers, 32 glasses and 4 jugs.

The **heating is electric** and is operated by tokens costing £1.50 each. These are found in the wall box holding all the electrical switches (to the right of the door as you go in) and should be fed into the meter. Cash is preferred but a BACS transfer can be made if the booking secretary is informed. Lighting costs are included within the hire charge and tokens are not required for the hall lights.

The Hall is ideal for meetings, children's parties, lunch parties, exercise classes (up to 10 people), coffee mornings and jumble sales.

It is **not** licenced to sell alcohol. Details for obtaining an alcohol licence (if required) is included in the conditions for hire document.

Hall equipment may be borrowed with the advance approval of the booking secretary, and an appropriate donation would be expected. Equipment cannot be borrowed if it clashes with a pre-booked event in the hall, so please do check the website before contacting the booking secretary should equipment be needed.
