Bouncy Castle/Inflatable Policy



At Newbald Village Hall we have until recently not allowed the use of bouncy castles and similar inflatables.

From Jan 2022, we will consider parties involving bouncy castles subject to the hirer fulfilling both of the conditions below and providing evidence in writing (email is ok).

1. A copy of the equipment provider's current public liability insurance certificate
2. Confirmation from the hirer's own insurers that they have third party cover which would cover any claims made against them in the event of any incident while they are supervising the activity. A responsible adult must supervise the equipment at all times and it is this person who should provide evidence of suitable cover.

We are advised by our insurers that meeting condition 2 should be straightforward in that most household policies should cover this without any additional cost.

If you cannot meet condition 2, taking out separate "event insurance" would suffice and this can be obtained online but please ensure you make it clear what the event is and that the cover is appropriate.
