

PEARSON HALL SAFEGUARDING UPDATE

AUGUST 2021

Following Step 4 in July 2021 all legal COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted and replaced with guidance.

The basic principle that now applies is that individuals are responsible to take such precautions to guard against infection as they deem to be appropriate but sensible precautions are recommended such as wearing masks in crowded areas and maintaining good ventilation in confined spaces.

The Pearson Hall Management Committee has reopened the hall to its users. The responsibility for safeguarding users is the responsibility of the hirer. In keeping with the government advice previous restrictions are lifted so the previous Special Conditions of Hire that applied during the COVID-19 pandemic are no longer mandatory however users are strongly advised to review the precautions that were incorporated in the Special Conditions as they may consider them to be appropriate for their own groups.

When appropriate hirers should follow the advice provided by national or local organisations covering their specific activity

The trustees will keep the QR code posted on the entry door and the posters recommending a one-way system and other precautions will remain up for the time being as guidance.
