

BOUNCY CASTLES

The Pinder Recreational Trust does allow the use of bouncy castles inside the Portal Hall Burghclere under the following conditions:

When booking, the hirer must declare that they intend to **hire** a bouncy castle. This declaration will imply a commitment to make sure that:

The bouncy castle will operate under the terms of the hire

Public liability insurance will be provided either by the supplier or the hirer – evidence must be available throughout the duration of the hire

Soft matting covering hard surfaces must be placed adjacent to the front or open sides.

A full briefing by any supplier should be given at the commencement of the hire to the designated hirer

The condition regarding the number and age of any children able to use the bouncy castle at any one time must be adhered to.

The Portal Hall does have some restrictions on the size of bouncy castles due to the 'tie bars' across the Hall. Most local bouncy castle suppliers can advise on what can be accommodated within the Main Hall.

Bouncy castles personally owned are not allowed unless full evidence of insurance is provided at the time of booking.

Please note the Hall's Insurance does not cover use of bouncy castles.

Outside bouncy castles are not allowed unless permission is granted by the Pinder Trust and extra precautionary conditions are in place and the location agreed.

The Trust reserves the right to prohibit the use of bouncy castles, or even cancel the booking if evidence is not provided on request.
