Alcohol Policy

The licensing law requires that there is a licence for the sale of alcohol at all events. The sampford Peverell Village Hall Management Committee has been granted its own licence for community functions. This includes the sale of alcohol. Condition 1 of this licence states that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be authorised by the Hall committee.

The licence is in the name of the Management Committee and not an individual person. *This licence is only allowed to be used when the Management Committee has granted permission for its use.* Without permission to use the licence, it is illegal to sell alcohol and it must not be sold at any event.

Any persons wishing to use the Village Hall licence must:

- Make a request to the Management Committee via the Bookings Secretary.
- Provide a named person who will be responsible for serving alcohol and who will agree to familiarise themselves with the terms and conditions for serving alcohol.
- Ensure permission is confirmed, prior to advertising that alcohol is to be sold at the event.
- In all cases where alcohol is supplied, whether sold or provided for free, *it is the responsibility of the licence holder or the hirer to ensure that no underage person can consume alcohol, under any circumstances.* If there is any doubt about a person's age, credible identification must be provided.
