Alcohol & Licensing Statement

Shropham Village Hall does not allow any hirers to provide their own alcohol to any event unless agreed beforehand in line with the below policy direction.

Alcohol & Licensing Policy Direction

Shropham Village Hall has a fully licensed, well stocked, and managed bar which is available to cater for your event. The following Policy direction must be adhered to regardless of whether the bar is to be included as part of your event:

1. You must NOT bring your own alcohol onto the site.
2. Only Sayers Bar can sell alcoholic drinks on the premises.
3. We reserve the right to confiscate, any alcohol brought onto the premises by hirers or their guests.
4. No alcohol is to be bought for the consumption of any person(s) under the age of 18. Should this be discovered, the Bar staff have the authority to close the bar and the event will be ceased immediately asking all persons to leave the Village Hall premises.
5. If the bar is hired, a separate bar agreement – subject to extra terms and conditions must be signed by the hirer.
6. If you book the Wedding Package, it is possible for hirers to provide a small alcoholic welcome drink for your guests, such as one glass of champagne for a toast, but this must be agreed in advance, writing in, with Sayers Bar committee.

These instructions are put in place to ensure the safety and protection of any hirers using the hall and their direction is expected to be followed.

As part of the booking process, we require all Hirers, where alcohol is involved, to sign to say they understand and will comply with the above procedures.
