

Security and Safety at the hall.

Following the dreadful attacks in Southport we must draw from this the importance of keeping our building at Holmcroft safe for all users. We may feel, as did the people of Southport, that we live in a safe area but that does not mean that we should not be vigilant.

- The front door should be locked from the inside once you feel that all members of your group are in the building. If there is a latecomer, they can always phone you or knock on the window. This is particularly important if you are in The Wilton Room at the back.
- The rear door should also be locked, even if it means responding repeatedly to members arriving.
- If someone you don't know knocks at the locked door, you are not obliged to open it or let them in. If necessary, write my number (07904 380 760) on a piece of paper and show this to them.
- Don't be anxious but please be vigilant.

We have asked before that doors are kept closed to prevent the waste of indoor heating but the safety issue is paramount and the doors should be closed and locked.
