

## **Bouncy Castles Policy - Stowupland Village Hall**

Bouncy Castles can only be used on Village Hall owned land in accordance with the following policy.

For the avoidance of doubt this covers all Village Hall owned land including the playing fields, Bowls Club and all parts of the Village Hall building.

1. Bouncy castles can be used inside the Main Hall as part of a hire at no extra cost. However the castle must be erected at the end of the Hall away from the stage to prevent damage to the projector.
2. Bouncy castles can be used outside the Hall but there is a charge of £10 an hour.
3. The Village Hall Trustees have no liability insurance to cover bouncy castles activities on Village Hall land.
4. The Village Hall Trustees accept no responsibility for damage or loss while the equipment is on Village Hall land, this include damage to the structure of the buildings or land which is at the hirers risk.
5. It is the hirers responsibility to ensure equipment will fit in the Main Hall without damaging the ceiling.
6. The hirer must have liability insurance to cover the time on hire on Village Hall land. A copy of the insurance must be supplied to the Booking Secretary prior to the event
7. The Bouncy Castle Operative must have an up-to-date risk assessment. A copy of the risk assessment must be supplied to the Booking Secretary if requested prior to the event
8. The Bouncy Castle needs to be supervised by the supplier or a suitably competent adult at all times while in use.
9. As per the standard hire agreement all portable electrical equipment requires a current electrical PAT test
10. If any of these points are not covered then the Booking Secretary will not accept the booking.
