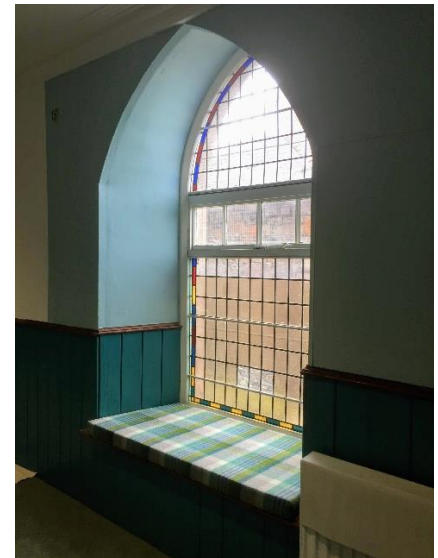

Welcome to Wooler Warm Hub! The purpose of the Warm Hub is to create a safe and warm place where people can meet in comfort with others and spend some time – maybe joining in with some social activities, getting some help and advice or perhaps just meeting friends and new people.



So, we want to let the Warm Hub to community and not-for-profit organisations that share our goals and aspirations, recognising that the Warm Hub lies within a Church building.

We don't anticipate normally hiring the facilities to commercial activities or for celebratory parties, but to groups of people who share our goal of improving community life and relationships here in Wooler and Glendale.

We would like as many people as possible to enjoy our facilities, so we've worked hard with the good folk of Wooler URC to make the building as accessible as possible.

There is a level entrance at the top door of the Church, with a ramp inside to help you negotiate a change of level.



We have a fully accessible WC which also accommodates a baby changing facility. Our colour scheme, signage, door handles and crockery have all been chosen to make life as easy as possible for those who have particular needs. However if we've missed something, please let us know!

Comfortable seating around 5 circular tables encourages good conversations – as does our cosy corner with a sofa and easy chairs. Warm carpets, efficient gas heating via radiators and blackout blinds complete the set up, which is entirely designed to help our visitors feel relaxed and at home.

A quality sound and projection system with HDMI and VGA connections makes it easy to show films or give presentations – please ask for a demonstration when making your booking if you would like to use this facility.

Our kitchen is fitted with stainless steel units which meet the latest food safety standards. A range cooker means that light refreshments for up to 30 people can be easily prepared.

The kitchen also has a fridge, a microwave and a good selection of pans and utensils.



Within the main Hub room there is a coffee bar with a constant water boiler for instant preparation of hot drinks. We also have a filter coffee machine. Fairtrade tea, coffee and sugar is provided, you just need to bring your own milk and biscuits.

Crockery and cutlery for up to 30 people is stored in the coffee bar.
