

# General Information

The hall can be configured from theatre style (seating capacity 140), cabaret style (up to 120 capacity seated at 12 x 5' round tables), 18 trestle 6'x3' tables in any configuration and 220 standing for concerts. 140 chairs with red fabric seats and backs as well as 36 traditional plastic bucket seats.

Free WIFI is also available for users of the hall and an access point extends the service into the playing field and playground at the rear.

There is a catering kitchen with catering cookers and hob, large fridge and under counter freezer, professional dishwasher, warming cupboard, pot wash, food preparation and hand wash sinks, constant catering boiling water dispenser, together with stainless steel food preparation tables.

A stage with crimson stage curtains with side blacks and mid stage black that can be drawn across the stage.

Dressing/changing rooms, bench seating and kit hooks – two rooms for Home and Away Teams on sporting days with two electric showers in each, WC and wash hand basin. The basic sport fittings can be supplemented with tables and chairs for stage performers as required.

Lighting rig and mounting bars both above and in-front of the stage and on the stage – lighting fittings of various types. Two group multi channel control board with two remote control points within the hall. Working lights on stage and dimmable house lights in the main body of the hall, separate from the day to day hall lighting. Lighting has been used for theatrical and music productions alike and the lighting bar rig has been used by touring shows.

Sound equipment consists of wall mounted Wolfdale speakers with a power amp. DJ and sound mixers are available. Sound sources include both wired and radio microphones, DJ twin CD unit and mixing desk. Also available is a Bluetooth receiver which allow phone or pad connection.

Projector facilities are available and for movie night “Films at The Hall” we use the rear white wall of the stage as a screen as this is some 5 meters in width.

On the stage is a separate power, commando socket, supply for visiting acts with own rigs.

A traditional piano is also available.

There is free parking for up to 36 cars with the halls own car park with two disabled spaces. Supplementary parking for functions can sometimes be arranged at the rear of the hall. The car park is shared with Worthen Medical Practice during weekday business hours and is also the dedicated drop off location for Long Mountain School who have an access path on the western side of the hall. At the front of the hall is a memorial garden and 8 metre flag pole.

The hall grounds extend at the rear of the hall down to the local byway known as Back Lane and include a football pitch which is the home ground for Brockton Rovers Football Club plus there is a crown green for Worthen and Brockton Bowling Club. There is also a fenced children’s playground with swings and climbing frames.
