

Welcome to the Bowling Green Campsite in Weston Subedge

We're delighted to have you stay with us! By paying a deposit or the full amount for your pitch, you agree to follow the campsite rules below:

Fire Safety

- **Please leave enough space between tents, caravans, motorhomes, and any other structures – we recommend at least 6 metres – to help prevent fires spreading.**
 - **Take time to learn where the fire escape routes are and think about what you would do in case of fire.**
 - **Check to see where the fire extinguisher is located**

Fresh water

- **Taps are available on the main hall building and by the toilet on the end of the bowling club building**

Generators

- **Generators may only be used during daylight hours. Please do not use them after dark.**

Firepits and Barbecues – Sorry no disposable BBQs

- **Only use them in calm conditions and away from flammable materials.**
 - **Always make sure fires and barbecues are fully out before you leave.**
 - **You must have a way to extinguish a fire nearby – for example, a bucket of water.**

Respecting Others

- **Quiet Hours: Please keep noise to a minimum after 10pm.**
 - **Privacy: Be considerate and respect the space and privacy of your fellow campers.**
 - **Noise: Keep the volume down on music, appliances, and general activity – especially at night.**
 - **Tidy Pitch: Please keep your area clean and tidy.**
 - **Waste: Use the bins provided for rubbish – these are located at the back of the main car park or behind the hall**

Vehicles and Electricity

- **Drive Carefully:** Stick to 5 mph when driving on the campsite.
 - **Electric Hook-Up:** Be mindful not to exceed the power limit available at your pitch. This facility is only currently available in the tents
 - **Waste Water:** Please empty grey water (from sinks/showers) only at the designated disposal point – also at the back of the main car park.

Other Important Points

- **Children:** Children must be supervised at all times and behave respectfully around the site.
 - **Pets:** Dogs must be kept on leads and cleaned up after.
 - **Visitors:** There may be a small charge for any visitors you invite to the site.
 - **Check to see where the defibrillator is located** (to the left of the bar door at the side of the building.
 - **Finally the bleed kit is located inside the bar kitchen**
